

2014 TJCSA Bylaw recommended changes:

1. Article IX – Committees

Section 1.

j. Scholarship Committee

Section 11 . ~~The President shall appoint other committees as the need arises to serve the best interest of the Association, and these committees shall serve during the terms of the appointing President.~~ Scholarship Committee. It shall be the duty of this committee to determine and select which TJCSA members meet the requirements of the application(s) and make recommendations to the Executive Committee as to selected applicants from each region.

Section 12. The President shall appoint other committees as the need arises to serve the best interest of the Association, and these committees shall serve during the terms of the appointing President.

2. Article XIII– Board of Trustees

section 1. Past Presidents of the Association still actively employed by a Juvenile Court. ~~or former Past Presidents shall be eligible for Board of Trustee emeritus membership.~~ Former Past Presidents who have emeritus membership status shall continue to be a Board of Trustees member.

section 3. The Board of Trustees shall also receive direction at the will of the President and the ~~Advisory Board~~ Executive Committee.

3. Article XIV – Amendments to Bylaws

Section 5. The bylaws shall be reviewed and voted on at the annual meeting of the Association, ~~regardless of any changes~~ in order to approve any revisions.

4. Article XVI – Financial Assets upon Dissolvement

Section 1. If the TJCSA was to be dissolved all financial assets at that time, after all financial obligations have been met, will be equally distributed to the existing college scholarships that TJCSA founded.
