

## CHARLES CAMPBELL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Tennessee Juvenile Court Services Association established the Charles Campbell Scholarship Foundation Fund in order to provide monetary assistance to retired Juvenile Court employees who have been active participants in the Association. The Charles Campbell Scholarship will encourage as well as assist retirees to attend the annual Joint Conference on Juvenile Justice. The 33<sup>rd</sup> Joint Conference on Juvenile Justice will be held at the Peabody Hotel, Memphis TN, from August 14-August 17, 2016.

Applicants for the scholarship must have been employed by a Juvenile Court for at least twenty years and retired from court employment. Applicants must also have been a member in good standing and an active participant in TJCSA for at least ten years. The scholarship will pay for up to three night lodging and registration fees at the annual Joint Conference. Recipients will be responsible for meals not provided at the conference, transportation expenses and additional fees for guest.
