



CHARLES TRAUGHBER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Tennessee Juvenile Court Services Association established the Charles Traughber Scholarship Foundation Fund in order to provide monetary assistance to **Juvenile Court staff**, which would enable them to attend the annual Joint Conference on Juvenile Justice. The scholarship will pay for up to three nights' lodging, parking and registration fees. Recipients will be responsible for meals not provided at the conference, transportation expenses and any additional guest fees. Attendance at all workshops and the annual business meeting is a requirement in order to receive the scholarship. The 34th Joint Conference on Juvenile Justice will be held at the Airport Marriott Hotel, 600 Marriott Drive, Nashville, TN from August 13 – August 16, 2017.

Due to limited funding available, the determination of who receives this scholarship will be based upon the application.
